### Smarter ways of working

*Effective public assets driving transformation*

Scotland's public sector organisations are considering office workspace as a target for creating a smaller, leaner, greener, and more effective and smarter property estate, an initiative the Scottish Future Trust (SFT) has led on for a number of years. The essence of this approach is increased sharing in fewer buildings, improving collaboration, delivering significant efficiencies and savings, and identifying opportunities for wider benefits based on new modern ways of working.

NHS Highland identified that it could move to a smarter and more agile working environment by moving from six offices down to two through delivery of future-proofed workplaces.

SFT's workplace team worked with NHS Highland at all stages of this project to help them understand smarter working, to support the required cultural change and to help them deliver modern, 21st century office workplaces with maximum flexibility.

Not only has this project reduced the carbon footprint of the NHS Highland's offices, but has delivered recurring savings of £0.5m a year.
